

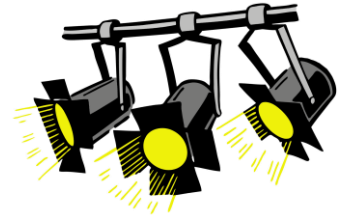
Wow! What a great first week back that has been.

The Jaguars came back to school after lockdown full of enthusiasm, determination and positivity. It has been lovely to see them laugh, play and learn together with their friends.

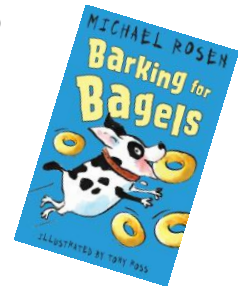
