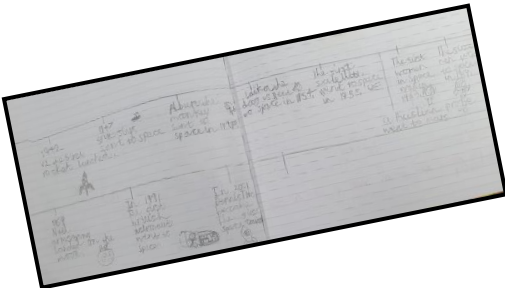




Spotlight on the Tigers Class..

So far this term the Tigers have been learning all about Space. We have linked most of our subjects to our Science topic.



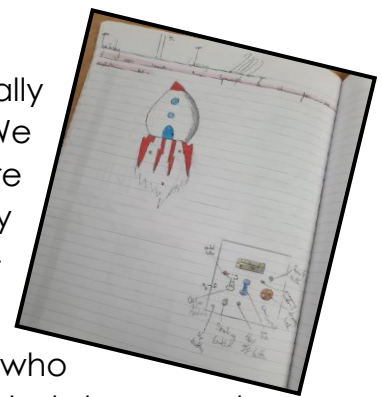
In Science we have learned about the different planets and completed research to find out facts. We also learned about Space Race, moon phases and completed an experiment to find out which

We have been exploring explanation texts in English and worked really hard to get the balance between instruction and explanation right. We wrote our explanations about rockets which we had designed. We are also writing some narrative based on a black hole and where it may take us or a character. We are learning about the structure of narratives and how to create characters and settings within our writing.



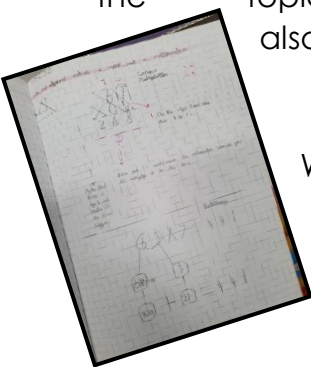

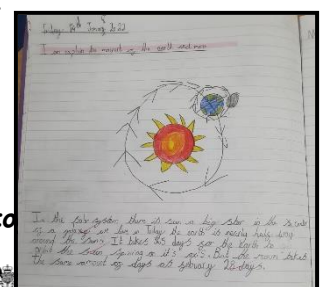
In PE we are doing dance. Our theme is the Winter Olympics and we
