

### Maths – Place Value & Addition & Subtraction

We will be learning about place value up to 20 and addition and subtraction within 20. Both year groups will focus on fluency through and daily arithmetic.

### Science – Introduction to Plants

We will be looking at identifying different plants and trees. We will be looking at how plants and trees grow and what they need to survive.

### DT – Mechanisms

We will be looking and how to make things move and then making a fairground wheel.

### Art – Drawing

We will be looking at basic drawing skills, learning how to draw in a range of ways.

### History – How am I making history?

We will be learning about our own history and the history of our family members. We will be looking at similarities and differences between past and present.

### Geography – What is it like here?

We will be doing a local area study to look at where we live and our local area. We will also be developing our understanding of maps and how they are used.

## **Year 1 & 2 Autumn Term 1**

### PSHE – Families & Relationships

We will be looking at what makes a good friend and what families are.

### Music – Animals

We will be learning to sing African call and response songs, creating sound patterns.

### English – Stories with Imaginary Settings & Non-Chronological Reports

We will begin by focusing on basic sentence writing skills. Children will then explore writing a story with an imaginary setting and a non-chronological report.

### Whole Class Reading – Esio Trot

We will be reading 'Esio Trot' and focussing on developing fluency.

### PE – Gymnastics

We will be learning how to move our bodies in a range of ways, also using equipment.

### RE – What do some people believe God looks like?

We will be looking at what different religions believe about their god.

### Computing – Mouse Skills

We will be learning to use and developing basic mouse skills on a laptop.
