As mathematicians, we will be learning how to solve problems involving ratio and angles. We will also be doing lots of revision in preparation for our SATs.

Science: Evolution and inheritance

As scientists, we will explore variation and inheritance in different living things and how observations and fossil evidence have led to the theory of evolution.
